The Green Team at Christ the Servant want to thank the small, but enthusiastic group who joined us on Earth Day to watch the movie **“Before the Flood”** featuring Leonardo DiCaprio and Pope Francis. Following are some key points from the movie:

1. Pope Francis has called on the world community to accept the science on climate change.
2. The encyclical *Laudato Si’*, puts out a **call** for immediate action to stop global warming and a **cry** for justice for the poor, who are suffering the most from the effects of climate change.
3. Climate change is reversible. Public opinion drives change. A carbon tax would be effective.
4. 300 million people in India have no electricity and cook with biomass, like dried cow dung.
5. Farmer’s crops and indigenous people’s homes have been washed away by historic flooding.
6. Greenland and the Arctic are rapidly melting and are on track to melt completely.
7. In the last 30 years, 50% of all coral has been lost.
8. Palm oil production drives the deforestation of critical rain forests in Indonesia.
9. Beef consumption drives the deforestation of Amazon rain forests in South America.
10. The fossil fuel industry finances climate change deniers.
11. Electricity consumed by one American is equivalent to that of 61 citizens of Nigeria.
12. After public outcry over pollution, China now invests the most in sustainable energy.
13. Tesla is building a Gigafactory that stores solar energy in batteries. 100 similar gigafactories could power the entire world with clean energy.
14. Pope Francis speaks with hope that we can always re-direct our steps and that we can see signs that things are now reaching a breaking point. He stresses we need to speak out on this issue as loud as we can, and most importantly, we need to pray for the human race.

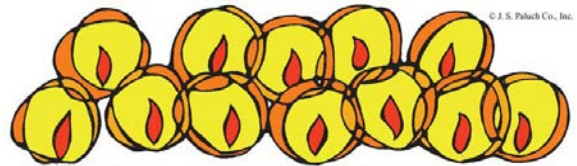

One in every 8 U.S. couples experience infertility, but Catholic couples face additional confusion, worry, and frustration as they explore the medical options available to them. Filling a major void in Catholic resources, The Infertility Companion for Catholics: Spiritual and Practical Support for Couples, authored by Carmen Santamaria and angelique Ruhi-Lopez, describes the Church's teaching on reproductive technologies, and provides a rich spiritual perspective on the emotions and faith involved in embracing the cross of infertility. The authors both experienced periods of being unable to conceive, and they walk in solidarity with readers, compassionately coaching them through the challenging landscape of infertility. The book includes:

- a variety of spiritual resources: prayers, devotions, and wisdom of the saints.
- a chapter designed for friends and family of infertile couples, with tips on how to relate to the couple with compassion and sensitivity.
- appendices suggesting further reading, reference materials, Catholic document, and Catholic blogs.

**rites of Christian Initiation** Adults interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith, the celebration of Baptism, Eucharist and/or Confirmation are invited to contact the parish office.

**BAPTISM OF INFANTS** Baptisms are usually celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month (except during Lent) at 11:30 AM. A Baptism Preparation Class must be attended if you are planning your first child's baptism or if three years have passed since your last child was baptized. Call the Parish Office to register and to check whether adjustments have been made to the schedule.

**MARRIAGE** Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.

**RECONCILIATION** Available Saturdays from 4:00-4:30 pm (except Holy Saturday), or by appointment with Fr. Bob.
