Over thirty years ago, St. Jude's Ranch Recycled Card Program was born. Christmas and All occasion greeting cards are recycled by Kids' Corp. The program at St. Jude's Ranch, located in Boulder City, Nevada, gives the children an opportunity to learn entrepreneurship skills. They use the front of donated cards and attach a new back to make beautiful cards sold in packets of ten for \$17.00. The benefits are two-fold: customers receive "green" holiday cards for use, and the children receive payment for their work and learn the benefits and importance of "going green".

We are able to collect and send donated cards to St. Jude's Ranch. Here are the rules:

1. ALL types of cards are used: Christmas, Religious, Easter, Birthday, Thank You, and All Occasion General Greeting Cards.
2. HALLMARK, DISNEY, or AMERICAN GREETING cards **cannot** be accepted (copyright rules)
3. Only the front can be used—be sure it is clear of ANY handwritten note.

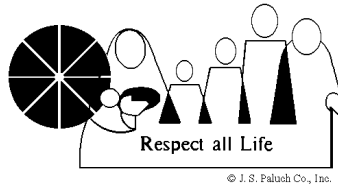

## Respect for All Life

### World Day for Consecrated Life



Consecrated life is a blessed gift when Jesus Christ chooses a person to answer His great call of love in a distinct and special way. He requests that person leave behind features of the world such as marriage and wealth to serve their brothers and sisters. Consecrated life is a vocation, like marriage and priesthood, where men and women seek an intimate relationship with Christ. They are witnesses to the world, called to unite with Christ, choosing to live out their vocation by professing the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. They do this by joining a religious congregation, a secular institute, or through private vows. The USCCB states that the World Day of Consecrated Life is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in February. Like the candles which are blessed in February symbolizing Christ (Candlemas), who is the light of the world, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Christ to all peoples. This celebration of those in Consecrated Life, during this weekend in February, highlights the gift of consecrated persons as light for the whole Church.

## Sacramental Information

**rites of Christian Initiation** Adults interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith, the celebration of Baptism, Eucharist and/or Confirmation are invited to contact the parish office.

**BAPTISM OF INFANTS** Baptisms are usually celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month (except during Lent) at 11:30 AM. A Baptism Preparation Class must be attended if you are planning your first child's baptism or if three years have passed since your last child was baptized. Call the Parish Office to register and to check whether adjustments have been made to the schedule.

**MARRIAGE** Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.

**HOLY ORDERS:** Are you thinking of becoming a priest or religious? Talk with Fr. Bob or email Fr. Steven Borello at [vocations@dioceseofjoliet.org](mailto:vocations@dioceseofjoliet.org).

**RECONCILIATION** Available Saturdays from 4:00-4:30 pm (except Holy Saturday), or by appointment with Fr. Bob.

**PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK** Please contact the parish office for a visit from a priest when sickness occurs or death is imminent for the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. To arrange for Communion to be brought to the sick/homebound members of the parish community, call Deacon Tom F.

**FUNERALS** Arrangements for funerals are usually made in cooperation with the attending funeral home. Contact the parish office for pre-planning of funerals.

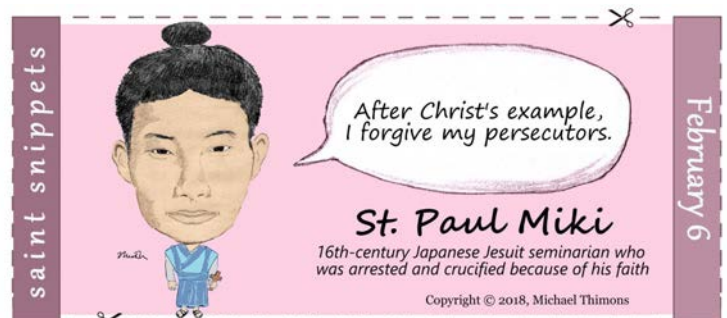
