CTS will accepting donated hams, any weight, fresh or canned on April 2nd, Palm Sunday.



RITES OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION Adults interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith, the celebration of Baptism, Eucharist and/or Confirmation are invited to contact the parish office.

BAPTISM OF INFANTS Baptisms are usually celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month (except during Lent) at 11:30 AM. A Baptism Preparation Class must be attended if you are planning your first child's baptism or if three years have passed since your last child was baptized. Call the Parish Office to register and to check whether adjustments have been made to the schedule.

MARRIAGE Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.






Jesus: The Way, the Truth, and the Life



Join Us For a Holy Hour on Friday's During Lent





"The most important thing to realize about making a private Holy Hour is that

you don't have to do anything. You don't have to say any particular prayers, or read, or sing, or anything else. All you have to do is be present to the One who is present to you. Certainly, bodily presence is a first step—at times that is all we are capable of—but we should also try to be present with our hearts. This means a living awareness of who is present. Many times, we need to be silently present—not analyzing, thinking, or saying prayers with our lips. "Be still and know that I am God." Ps 46.

... As we sit in silence before the Lord, we are irradiated by his Eucharistic presence. We all need "radiation therapy"—and to receive it, we only need to be *present*, just as in sunbathing we only need to be present to the ultra-violet radiation of the sun."
