


At this time, we continue to record the mass for people who are not able to make it to church, posting it by 4:30 pm Saturdays on the YouTube channel christtheservant.



RITES OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION Adults interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith, the celebration of Baptism, Eucharist and/or Confirmation are invited to contact the parish office. ۲

BAPTISM OF INFANTS Baptisms are usually celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month (except during Lent) at 11:00 AM. A Baptism Preparation Class must be attended if you are planning your first child's baptism or if three years ۲ have passed since your last child was baptized. Call the Parish Office to register and to check whether adjustments have been made to the schedule. ٠

MARRIAGE Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.


Religious Formation Classes will not meet on November 20-22 for the Thanksgiving holiday. Class will resume November 27-29.

No child should be denied being taught about God just because their parents cannot afford to send their child or children to religious classes. To help our parents pay for Religious Formation classes. we have started Religious Formation Sponsorship program. We invite you to become part of the Faith Forward, Christ the Servant Religious Formation's Sponsorship Program. Βv sponsoring the faith formation of a child - by passing your faith forward — you help to lay the foundation and shape the future of both our children and the whole of our Catholic community

There are several ways to financially assist in Faith passing your faith forward:

A \$175.00 donation will pay for one year of religious formation tuition

\$100.00 will pay for the Sacrament fee of a child who cannot afford the fees for receiving a Sacrament

\$25.00 will purchase a child's textbook for the year.

Other sponsorships such as retreat expenses, high school programs, speaker engagements, classroom audio/video equipment are also available.

Sacrament Reminder

Don't forget, if your child is planning on making a Sacrament the Diocese of Joliet requires children complete a minimum of two consecutive years of Religious Formation before receiving Sacraments. Typically, in 2nd grade, our children receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the late fall and the Sacrament of Eucharist in the spring. (Children must have participated in RF in first and second grade or two other consecutive years of preparation). Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, which will be conferred at the end of 8th grade according to the Bishop's schedule begins in 6th and 7th grade. (Full participation in RF in 7th and 8th grade is

the minimum enrollment required.)

Electricity generation contributes significantly to earth warming greenhouse gas emissions. Consider and shop for green electricity sources for your home. One simple way is to use a 2nd party provider that guarantees to repurchase certified wind or solar power equivalent to your household demand. You 'll be reducing your environmental footprint and supporting renewable energy growth. The process should be seamless: no equipment or service interruption required. Compare rates and select a supplier where the clean energy charge is the same or at a negligible increase. Compare to: www.aepenergy.com/residential/renewable-energy/

You can also explore community solar (CS) as another alternative. There are no panels on your roof. With CS you "subscribe" to get the equivalent amount of power that your home uses generated from a remote solar farm.
