

**RECONCILIATION**: Available Saturdays from 4:00-4:30 pm (except Holy Saturday), or by appointment with Fr. Bob.



**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months in advance by contacting the Parish Office to set the date and reserve the church. Reserve the church before you reserve the reception hall.

**FUNERAL:** Arrangements for funerals are usually made in cooperation with the attending funeral home. Contact the parish office for pre-planning of funerals.

# LEONARD M. JARKA SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS ANNOUNCED

Winners of the Leonard M. Jarka Memorial Scholarships for 2024 were recently announced by Knights of Columbus Council 5918 serving St. Scholastica and Christ the Servant Parishes.

Scholarship applicants must demonstrate high levels of performance in the classroom and in activities outside the classroom. They must show a commitment to and experience with volunteerism. This quality must be supported by the candidates' own essays on the meaning of volunteerism, as well as through letters submitted by a sponsor, a school counselor, and from the candidates themselves as to their fitness to receive the award.


#### This Summer, Youth Group is back!

#### **Sacrament Reminder**

Don't forget, if your child is planning on making a Sacrament the Diocese of Joliet requires children complete a minimum of two consecutive years of Religious Formation before receiving Sacraments. Typically, in 2nd grade, our children receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the late fall and the Sacrament of Eucharist in the spring. (Children must have participated in RF in first and second grade or two other consecutive years of preparation). Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, which will be conferred at the end of 8th grade according to the Bishop's schedule begins in 6th and 7th grade. (Full participation in RF in 7th and 8th grade is the minimum enrollment required.)



#### Creation Care Corner ( "Care for Creation"

#### Consider zero-waste options for

picnics, BBQ and camping meals. Reusable items add a touch of class, sensibility and significantly reduce waste. Use lightweight reusable plates, utensils, bowls, cups and cloth napkins. Get creative with packaging. Reusable containers? Of course. What about Mason jar desserts? Go heavy on finger foods: cut vegetables and mixed nuts. Wipe off food when finished and use a washable cloth bag to hold used dinnerware for dishwashing later. Reserve a bag for recyclables and a container for compostable. If you must go disposable, use biodegradable paper products instead of plastic. Ditch the straws. Use a large thermos for drinks. Take other beverages in metal or glass containers and recycle. Skipping bottled water saves money and the environment.
