**<u>FUNERAL:</u>** Arrangements for funerals are usually made in cooperation with the attending funeral home. Contact the parish office for pre-planning of funerals.







#### There are several ways to financially assist in passing your faith forward:


A \$175.00 donation will pay for one year of Faith religious education tuition

#### Gratitude, Generosity and Stewardship
